CIL 1969 to 1991 with work in ammonia, phosphoric acid and ammonium nitrate plants. Ammonia plants were 1000 STPD Kellogg and 1120 MTPD Uhde (ICI AMV design). During this period I was asked to represent ICI at the start-up of a ICI AMV ammonia plant in Puyang, PRC for Zhongyuan Chemical Fertilizers. This plant started in 1989/1990.

Saskferco 1991 to 2015 with work in ammonia, urea and HNO₃/UAN plants. The ammonia plant is a nominal 1500 MTPD plant and is heavily revamped, the urea plant is a 2000- MTPD Stamicarbon plant also heavily revamped. The HNO₃ plant was a US Army Corp of Engineers plant that we relocated to Canada and the UAN plant was an Uhde design. This company was bought by Yara in 2008. I retired from this plant in 2015 but continue to do work of Yara Trinidad in an as needed contract basis. Roles were Technical Manager, Operations Manager and Project Manager and Senior Engineer in recent years.

Yara Trinidad 2015 to Present. Major work was a revamp of a Fluor 1200 STPD plant and currently doing a feasibility study for one of the other plants
